SKATEBAORD DESIGN PROJECT



- Imagine you are a graphic designer and your boss comes to you and asks you to design the bottom or top of a skateboard.
- Your design must be your own original and creative idea!
- Your design must be drawn well and be completely colored in when finished.
 You can use any colored materials you would like (markers, colored pencils, crayons, paint, etc.). If you have no colored materials you can fully shade it different values with a pencil without losing points.



- The skateboard design must appeal to kids your own age (this is your audience).
- Questions to consider: What do kids your age like? What do they eat? What do they wear? What do they listen to? What games do they play? What TV shows or movies do they watch? What do they do in their free time?
- Everything in your design must be school appropriate. If you aren't sure, ask me first.



- Your design can be one big graphic or many smaller doodles put together.
- Your subject can be realistic or it can be completely made up and imaginary (like you see here)
- Your design can also include words, quotes, graffiti, song lyrics, etc.




- Consider adding a unique pattern to an object or objects in your design.
- Notice here how a unique pattern was created on the snake.
- Make sure the background is also colored in



- You can create a design for the top or the bottom of the skateboard.
- If you create a design for both the top and bottom you will receive up to 15 bonus points. The two designs must be different but should go together in their colors and theme.



- I have posted a template on this website for the top and bottom that you can print and draw on. Remember, you only need to do one.
- If you don't have a printer you will need to draw the top or bottom of the skateboard on your paper yourself.



ASSESSMENTS

- You need to email me the pencil drawing of your design before you start coloring for a progress grade. I will also give you feedback.
- When finished you will upload your colored skateboard design to Artsonia with a title and Artist Statement. You don't need to email me your colored design. Just upload it to Artsonia.




